



iPad Digital Scavenger Hunt

In teams, take a photo or video demonstrating as many of these tasks as possible. Put your photos and videos together using iMovie and post your completed video to your school's Padlet wall. Be sure to watch the clock and have fun!

1. Create a group of two or three. Take a group selfie and use Pic Collage to write your team name on your photo. Save the image to your Camera Roll.
2. Take a photo of an iPad's home button. The home button turns the iPad on if it is asleep and takes you out of an app and back to your home screen.
3. Take a video of a team member using five fingers to close apps and four fingers to switch apps.
4. Take a video of a team member double clicking home and explaining why you should occasionally turn off all opened apps.
5. Take a video of a team member locking their iPad and explaining why you should do this.
6. Arrange your apps into folders and take a screenshot of your folders. Recommended categories include images/video, organization, presentation, creation, research, library, study tools, math apps, science apps, etc.
7. Take a video of a team member splitting the keyboard and returning it to normal.
8. Take a video of a team member changing the screen from vertical to horizontal and locking and unlocking screen orientation.
9. Take a video of a team member searching for an app by swiping down on the home screen.
10. Change your email signature to your name and school. Take a screenshot of your new signature.
11. Take a video of a team member opening a new tab in the Airwatch browser and adding your school website as a favorite.
12. Take a photo of a team member pointing to the volume control, microphone, and forward facing camera. Try to get all of these in one photo.
13. Pull up on the bottom of the home screen, change Airdrop settings to Everyone and take a screenshot.
14. Go to Settings, Notification Center and turn off Notifications View and Today View from the Lock Screen. Take a screenshot.
15. Go online, find an image of an iPad, save to camera roll and use that image in Fotobabble or Chatterpix to share a few tips for proper iPad care. Examples include washing hands before use, keeping away from food or drink, and never leaving the iPad in a car.
